





CHAPTER 1: Wildfires: A Growing Threat Originally Aired: 02/02/2020

FOR DISCUSSION

Why has there been an increase in wildfires?



TERM TO KNOW—Indian Ocean Dipole (IOD)

Differences in the surface temperatures of the Indian Ocean between the east and the west create a 'dipole.' This dipole affects rainfall in both regions.

For example, warmer temperatures in the Indian Ocean in the west caused more rainfall and flooding in east Africa. Cooler temperatures in the east Indian Ocean caused drought in Australia. This pattern is a positive (+) Indian Ocean Dipole. A negative (-) process would have cooler Indian Ocean temperatures in the east and warmer ocean temperatures in the west. (This meteorological phenomenon has only been understood for the last 20 years.)



INVESTIGATIVE QUESTION

Check out this infographic from Australia's government's Bureau of Meteorology explaining IOD. Investigate:

- What conditions occur in Australia during a + IOD?
- What regions become drier?
- How does a + IOD compare to a IOD?
- Take a deeper dive and research El Niño and La Niña and how these meteorological cycles affect weather in the western hemisphere.

What is the process for scientists to research life beyond Earth?



TERM TO KNOW—Exoplanet

A planet which orbits a star outside of our solar system.



INVESTIGATIVE QUESTION

We know that for life to be sustained, water must be available. But what about other chemicals? There has been excitement about Venus' atmosphere and evidence of phosphine gas. What's the fuss all about? Jump online and determine how evidence of phosphine might lead to clues about:

- Whether Venus be habitable?
- If water existed on Venus?

TERM TO KNOW—Deep Fake

Video which uses artificial intelligence to change or alter faces and sound.



INVESTIGATIVE QUESTION

Radzi discussed the use of video deep fakes but students can examine how images are similarly doctored and spread through social media.

In January, 2020 an Australian photo of a girl wearing a gas mask, holding a koala, and standing in front of smoke went viral on Twitter. Students can imagine seeing the tweeted photo, determine the message of the photo, and then further read to discover how it was created by a photographer through Photoshop.
